

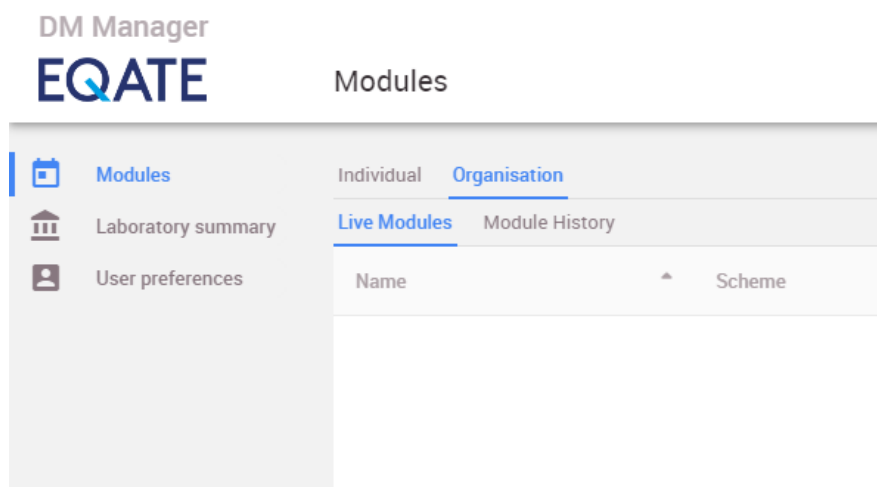
INSTRUCTION SHEET – Digital Haemosiderin

Logging in and getting started:

Once you have successfully logged in the Digital Morphology page below will load.



For those who are familiar with the platform, you will note there is a new 'Organisation' tab. The Haemosiderin survey will appear under the 'Live Modules' tab within the 'Organisation' tab.

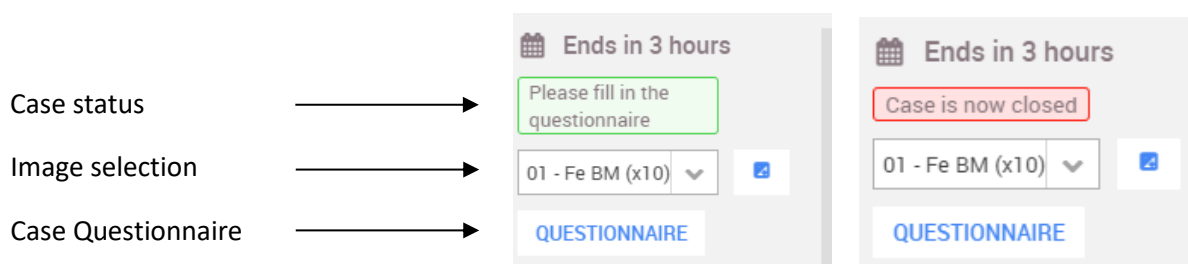
There are four stages to completing a Haemosiderin EQA Digital survey:

- View the case information carefully and then review the images
- Complete the questionnaire – please note that all team members registered for DM under your PRN will be able to login and participate in the case and can save their observations, however, once any participant chooses to click 'Submit', the case will be closed for any further editing and, as this is automated software UK NEQAS Haematology will be unable to

unlock the case for you or edit your results. Questionnaires which have been 'Saved' only will not be included in the final assessment.

- Submit the questionnaire before the case is closed
